Will savannah energy install a solar power plant in Chad?

Savannah Energy plans to install up to 300 MWof solar and a battery to power operations at its recently acquired Doba Oil project in Chad. It has also pledged up to 100 MW of solar and the same amount of wind to generate power for the capital, N'Djamena.

How many MW of solar will Chad have by 2021?

The International Renewable Energy Agency says Chad had 1 MWof grid-connected solar by the end of 2021. Savannah Energy has signed a deal with the government of Chad to develop up to 400 MW of solar-plus-battery projects in the country.

What is the largest energy project in Chad?
