

Can you recycle a battery?

Reduce fire risk and save precious resources by recycling your batteries. Common household batteries include lithium-ion button batteries from watches, hearing aids, etc., as well as standard barrel-type batteries (AAs, AAAs and so on). You must recycle these household batteries at dedicated battery collection points.

Can I return old batteries?

You are not obliged to make any purchase when returning old batteries. If you have ordered an electrical item for home delivery and would like to return your old like-for-like product, please call 03330 112 112 or email online@screwfix.com within 28 days of purchase to arrange collection.

Do I need to take back a car battery?

This includes (but is not limited to) AA, AAA and 9v batteries, rechargeable batteries and batteries from: You do not need to take back car and motorbike batteries or batteries from industrial equipment. You must have a collection point in your place of business.

How do I return an electrical item for home delivery?

If you have ordered an electrical item for home delivery and would like to return your old like-for-like product, please call 03330 112 112 or email online@screwfix.com within 28 days of purchase to arrange collection. Each local authority must also accept household WEEE and small batteries free of charge at its recycling facilities.

What is battery recycling?

For all returns, DOT and FAA regulations require that lithium batteries ship via sturdy, specially-marked boxes with static-free wrapping. All battery returns must be shipped in UN-spec boxes and packaged according to federal regulations. Packaging is available from your local UPS Store or Fedex/Kinkos store.

To recycle batteries, check local regulations and disposal options. Many communities have designated drop-off locations or recycling programs for batteries. You can also return them to some retailers that sell batteries. Ensure proper handling to avoid accidents, as batteries can contain hazardous materials. 2. Where to recycle household batteries?

For example, a 12-volt battery with a 650 CCA rating means the battery will provide 650 amps for 30 seconds at -18°C (0 °F) before the voltage falls to 7.20 V Volt for a 12 V Volt battery. So in extremely cold temperatures, the higher CCA level is required to crank your engine.

Alkaline Batteries - Also known as single-use batteries. Your typical AA, AAA, C, D, and 9V batteries that are used in things like remote controls, toys, and smoke detectors. Lithium Batteries - Another type of single-use battery. Does not contain heavy metals so may be difficult to recycle unless you pay a fee.

You can also send lithium batteries in the UK when they're sent with their device (except in their Royal Mail Tracked Returns, Business Response, Freepost, Royal Mail 24 and Royal Mail 48). These regulations ...
