Will China reach 30GW of energy storage by 2025?

The deployment of "new type" energy storage capacity almost quadrupled in 2023 in China, increasing to 31.4GW, up from just 8.7GW in 2022, according to data from the National Energy Administration (NEA). This means that China surpassed its target of reaching 30GW of the "new type" energy storage by 2025 two years earlier than planned.
