

Will there be a new battery plant in Europe in 2026?

Europe will see another battery plant come online in 2026. China-based battery maker Gotion High-tech and Slovak startup InoBat plans to build a battery factory in Slovakia. The facility will initially have an annual production capacity of 20GWh. Gotion and Inobat have formed a joint venture, Gotion Inobat Batteries (GIB), for the project.

Where will the first battery Gigafactory be located in Slovakia?

The first battery gigafactory in Slovakia will be located in Turany on a 95-hectare area and will create thousands of jobs. In the initial development stage, it will have a capacity of 20 GWh with the further potential to reach a capacity of up to 40 GWh.

Did Slovakia sign a joint venture agreement with the government?

The government and joint venture have now signed an Investment Agreement. The agreement does not come as a surprise. In November 2023, the companies signed a letter of intent to this effect with the Slovakian government regarding the factory. The partners had already presented the key points of the joint factory in September.

Will Slovakia shine again on the map of technologically advanced countries?

Denisa Sakova, Slovakia's economy minister, said in a statement that the country could shine again on the map of countries with technologically advanced industries because of the investment. Sakova said battery production will go hand in hand with Slovakia's tradition of automotive manufacturing.

Will Gib build a battery plant in Middle Europe?

The news came after Gotion said in September that it aims to build a battery plant in Middle Europe with Inobat, of which it has acquired a 25% strategic stake. According to the MoU signed on Wednesday, GIB plans to begin constructing the factory in 2024. The Slovak government will offer subsidies to the project and arrange the land.
