Can solar panels be installed on a combustible roof?

In general terms, solar panels should not be installed on combustible roofs unless some form of fire protection can be installed between the panels and the roof e.g. concrete panels or pebble ballast. 3. Location of solar panels

What should I consider before installing a solar roof?

Prior to installation, it is important to assess the roof's age, load-bearing capacity and very importantly the combustibility of the roof material and any insulation. A Freedom of Information request made last year has found a 12% increase in fires sparked by solar panels last year, compared to 2020.

How far should solar panels be from a roof?

Solar panel arrays should be kept at a minimum distance of 1 metre from roof edges and roof vents, to reduce the risk of a fire spreading. Solar panel arrays should be kept at a minimum distance of 5 metres from a fire wall, to reduce the risk of a fire spreading.

Can PV panels be installed on a new roof?

Where PV panels are to be installed on an existing roof, consideration should be given to the extra weight they will add. If you are planning to install panels on a new roof as part of a new build or reinstatement, it is important to be aware of the different risk implications of different roof types (e.g. flat vs pitched).
