

What is battery water?

There is no such thing as 'dilute acid,' which is commonly referred to as 'battery water.' Instead, it is a 33% sulphuric acid that is used as an electrolyte. Energy is stored when the potential difference while charging causes chemical reactions where tiny pockets of sulphate are pushed from the lead plates back into the dilute sulphuric acid.
